

Stylesheet

Please note that all documents will be reformatted into XML-TEI format for the purposes of digital archiving and web publishing. As such, the primary aim of the sdvig stylesheet is to ensure that the reformatting process is as easy as possible, not to produce a ready-to-publish print version.

Styling

Avoid custom styling (special fonts, font size, margins, indents, etc.). *Italics* and **bold** styling can be used.

Use preformatted styles for headings, text body and quotations.

A maxium depth of 3 headings is allowed.

Hyphenation

Do not use hard hyphens.

Quotation Marks

Use the standard quotation marks of the language of the document: « » in French, " " in English, etc. Quotation marks do not need to be harmonised across texts, if the texts are in different languages.

Citations

Use in-text Harvard style, with brackets for original edition: e.g. (Husserl 2010 [1901], 234-245).

Provide a complete list of references. The list does not need to be uniformally formatted or sorted.

Footnotes

Use footnotes only for additional comments. Citations must be in-text.

Place all footnote calls *after* punctuation: e.g. this is a footnote calls.¹
